

A Special Election will be held on **Tuesday, November 2, 2021** to fill the vacancy in the 22nd District of the Kentucky State Senate.

In-person absentee voting will be held on October 28th, 29th, 30th from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. at the Mercer County Clerk's Office located at 207 W Lexington Street (no-excuse needed). Mercer County snowbird voters will need to plan accordingly due to HB574.

Voters who qualify for a mail-in absentee ballot must request their ballots on the secure state portal at www.govoteky.com between September 18th – October 19th or you can call the Mercer County Clerk's Office at 859-734-6310. The deadline for voter to request through the absentee portal is October 19th and it will close at 11:59 p.m.

Mail-in ballots may be returned by mail or placed in the absentee ballot drop box inside of the Mercer County Courthouse located at 207 W Lexington Street. All ballots must reach the county clerk's office by 6:00 p.m. local time election night in order to be counted.

Mercer County will have four countywide voting centers and Mercer County voters may use whichever of the following locations that works best for them.
